Early autumn graces the lakes with warm, golden days and cooler nights, perfect for enjoying the stunning landscapes without the peak-season hustle. July and August are peak months, drawing crowds of tourists to the lakes, especially Lake Como and Lake Garda. Making it even better opportunity to escape to alternative lake destinations during this time.


#### DAY TRIPS AND LINK-UPS

Day trips to the Italian lakes are easily accessible from major cities like Milan, Verona, and even Venice. Milan provides excellent access to Lake Como, which is just over an hour away by train. For Lake Maggiore, the town of Stresa is also about an hour's train ride from Milan, making it an ideal daytrip destination. Verona, with its proximity to Lake Garda, is nearby popular lakeside towns like Sirmione.

Linking up between the lakes is also a great way to explore more of the region. For a unique experience, travel between Lake Como and Lake Maggiore or between Lake Garda and Lake Iseo, taking in the breathtaking landscapes that stretch between these gems of northern Italy.

While undeniably beautiful, its immense popularity brings large crowds, especially in peak season. From Bellagio's postcard-perfect waterfront to the historic estates of Tremezzo, Lake Como remains a must-visit, but one best enjoyed with thoughtful planning. For those seeking a more relaxed experience, nearby lakes such as Maggiore or Lugano provide stunning alternatives, with the added advantage of more affordable day trips to Lake Como.

#### WHO SHOULD VISIT

Lake Como is ideal for those seeking opulence mixed with world-class scenery. Its refined atmosphere appeals to honeymooners and travellers looking for an elegant getaway. However, it's also a great stop for film buffs and history lovers, with stunning villas like Villa Balbianello offering fascinating tours. Active travellers will enjoy hiking in the surrounding mountains, while boat lovers can cruise the lake's many charming towns. Those on a budget or seeking a quieter stay may prefer visiting for a day rather than staying overnight.

#### **GETTING THERE & AROUND**

**PLANE:** The closest major airport is in Milan, approximately a 1hr drive.

**TRAIN:** Arrive to Lake Maggiore via train to Arona, Regular trains run from Milan to Como (40min), and Varenna (1hr). It is also possible to access Lake Lugano via train from Cernobbio (1hr).

**CAR:** Driving is possible but not recommended, as the time taken between lakeside destinations is considerable, with small windy roads, and parking in many lakeside villages being limited and costly.

**BOAT:** From Como, ferries connect to Bellagio and other lakeside towns. Be mindful that pre-booked tickets are essential, and lines to get on the ferry can be length. A private boat is the best way to ensure plans run

- Crowds & Planning: As the most visited lake in Italy, Lake Como gets extremely busy, especially in summer Booking accommodations early is essential, along with pre-purchasing tickets for ferries, top attractions, and restaurant reservations to avoid long waits and disappointment.
- Ferries & Transport: Ferries are a scenic and convenient way to explore multiple towns, but they can be overcrowded. Pre-booking is highly recommended, and travellers should be aware that last-minute cancellations can occur. Private boat transfers offer a reliable but more costly alternative.
- Alternatives: Consider staying on nearby lakes, such as Maggiore or Lugano, that can provides a more peaceful and affordable experience while still allowing for day trips to Lake Como's highlights.

Hiking trails of all lengths and difficulties are in abundance, and two mountains (Monte Generoso and Monte San Salvatore) lie within easy reach to the Swiss town of Lugano. The region is also an ideal destination for a romantic lakeside getaway with a laidback way of life where you can stop and appreciate the scenic surroundings.

#### THINGS TO CONSIDER

- When staying in Lugano you receive a complimentary Ticino Card that allows unlimited travel on public transport during your stay. This is part of Switzerland's sustainable travel initiative, encouraging the use of shared transport option over private vehicle use.
- Day trips to Lake Como are a great way to experience the contrast of Lake Como's manicured gardens and Italian elegance, with the untamed wilderness of the Swiss alpine region making it a great alternative to staying in Lake Como.

#### **GETTING THERE & AROUND**

**PLANE:** The closest major airports to Lake Lugano are Milan and Turin if arriving in Italy, though we recommend flying into Milan for better train connections. If arriving from Switzerland, Zurich Airport offers the best connections, however Geneva is also an option if driving.

TRAIN: Arrive to Lugano in style onboard

the Gothard Panorama Express service from Lucerne (train and boat), or the Bernina Express service (train and coach) from St Moritz – both amazing journeys in their own right. Both panoramic services enjoy picturesque scenery through the Swiss countryside. If coming from Italy, regular train services operate from Milan (1 hour, 20 minutes) and Como (40 - 50 minutes).

**CAR:** Driving in and around Lake Lugano is a great way to explore the region. Roads are wider than other lake areas and several car rental companies have offices in Lugano. The drive from Milan is around 1 – 1.5 hours from Milan, 2 hours from Lucerne, and only 30 – 40 minutes from Como.

**PLANE:** TThe closest major airports to Lake Maggiore are Milan and Turin if arriving in Italy, though we recommend flying into Milan for better train connections.

**TRAIN:** Arrive to Lake Maggiore via train to Arona, Stresa or Verbania-Pallanza on the western side of the lake. If arriving to Locarno on the Swiss side in the north, regular trains operate from Zurich, taking a little over 2 hours. For a scenic and relaxed option, take the Centovalli Railway from Domodossola to Locarno.

**CAR:** Lake Maggiore is easy to explore by car, with a good network of roads connecting the main villages. Driving from Milan, Como or Lugano will take between 1–1.5 hours, making it an easy stop to include when self-driving through the Italian Lakes area.
